"Religious freedom in China has really reached to the worst level that has not been seen since the beginning of the Cultural Revolution by Chairman Mao [Zedong] in the 1960s," says Bob Fu, a former house church pastor in China. Fu came to the U.S. to found China Aid to warn of the growing persecution in China.

The picture that is shaping up is a highly controlled society with a personality cult. The control follows the

President Xi Jinping is the personality behind the cult. In the last 10 years, he has systemically restructured the government to put himself in permanent charge.

Control is escalating by using modern technology. Cameras are installed in churches to record who attends. It is now a crime not to watch state television.

As in Russia, the excuse for the crackdown is to "eliminate extremism." Detention camps have recently been constructed holding up to a million Uyghur Muslims in the western province of Xinjiang. Since the Christians, especially members of the unregistered "house" churches, are also considered "extremists" by the communist government, they are included in the government "elimination" efforts.

Churches are now being forced to hang pictures of Xi beside crucifixes and sing communist anthems during service. In some places, children under 18 are forbidden to attend church and Bible camps are being closed. Bibles and other "illegal promotional materials" are being confiscated and burned.

Authorities in some provinces are taking a harder line than others but the government has passed regulations directing the nation-wide shift toward less freedom. The emphasis is on forcing everyone to submit to the Communist Party and "Chinese" culture. And all rivals must be eliminated, including Christians. "Party members who have religious belief should have [be given] strengthened thought education," according to new government regulations released in February.

Some brave pastors have tried to resist. The persecution has become worse since new government regulations were published. At least 250 Chinese pastors have signed a public statement against

the regulations. It closed with: "For the sake of the gospel, we are prepared to bear all losses, —even the loss of our freedom and our lives."

This stand could be costly. Witness the invasion of one church in Henan province: 50 officials stormed the service, beat the worshippers and confiscated most of the church property. One grabbed the microphone from the pastor, read a document declaring the church "illegitimate" and demanded the pastor sign it. He refused and was taken away.

Some of the women attempted to video the attack and were beaten and kicked and their cell phones confiscated before they were taken into custody. Anyone who attempted to protect them was also beaten.

"For the first time, people throughout China are saying 'NO!' to what the Communist party wants—control. Control over what they can do, what they can believe, where they can go, what they can say. It's yet another sign something is beginning to take shape here in China, the call for democracy! The call for freedom!" says Christopher Gregory of China Missions.

Decades ago the people of China chose Communism's hollow dream instead of the Bible. Now, millions there have discovered the truth and are willing to die for it —and some may have to.

The same war is being fought in almost every other country in the world. Satan's time is short and he is outraged. America is an oasis in this battlefield, but for how long? Handing out a gospel tract can get you killed in some parts of the world.

Many have shed their blood to buy and protect our freedom. Are we grateful enough to exercise that freedom and just hand someone a tract?


words. That means we can stand up to any man, woman or child, or even the Devil himself, when he whispers lies against those words.

Why do a lot of people not witness to others? They don't have *confidence* in what they are saying. Look around: people who are confident in their favorite team spout it all around to all who will hear. But that confidence is lacking when it comes to what are God's words, and whether we can trust them. So, rather than call others to an uncertain faith, they just keep silent while their friends, neighbors, even enemies, tumble on toward a Christless eternity.

"But aren't you worshipping the Bible by believing its words?" It depends upon what you mean by that.

I believe the constitution and the penal code, and I don't worship *them*. But the Bible claims to be **God's exact words!** We will be judged by God in heaven if we add to them or take away from them. How can we believe in the penal code more than the holy words of the living God?

And "worshipping" has an old meaning, of "ascribing worth to" something or




someone. In that sense, the Bible is worth more than all the other books on earth combined! It alone contains all we need to know to get to heaven, have our sins forgiven, learn about who God

But it doesn't. A scholar is only as trustworthy as his sources of information and his personal agenda. When we examine the sources and the agendas, only one Bible comes up reliable.

Modern research methods have proven that the source manuscripts behind the modern bibles are corrupted and faked. They have also proven that the agenda of their scholars is highly questionable.

When We Take a Stand, Satan Loses

Hopeful signs are showing up that more people are beginning to stand against Satan's push to destroy America.

When the administration of Azusa Pacific University declared that the school would begin to accept same sex relationships on campus, the board of trustees blew the whistle.

The new code of conduct dropped longstanding language that declared "homosexual acts" as "expressly forbidden" by Scripture and declared "heterosexuality is God's design for sexually intimate relationships." The trustees voted to reinstate the original code and were immediately attacked by LGBTQ+ activists for their courage.

It is great to see schools that were founded by Bible believers standing strong against the unrighteous agenda. A couple of years ago Wheaton College near Chicago was embroiled in a struggle over their stand for biblical marriage.

Other secular colleges and universities are requiring a different approach. Here, the struggle is between First Amendment freedom of speech and new "discrimination" laws protecting homosexual "civil rights."

Several universities have tried to claim discrimination when a Christian campus club refused to allow homosexual leadership. The administration would cut off the club's share in student activity funding and even deny a place on campus for them to meet.

Anyone on campus attempting to speak or distribute literature with the biblical view would be promptly shut down or relegated to an obscure part of the campus or given a limited time frame. Organizations of Christian attorneys, such as Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF), are taking up these attacks and forcing, sometimes by going to court, the school officials to back down. Other organizations are marshalling the citizens

to attend legislative hearings on proposed laws threatening freedom of religion and speech.

In California, several victories occurred this session. One bill, AB 2943, planned to forbid any paid counselor from helping anyone with an unwanted same-sex attraction. The law was written so that even pastors could possibly have been restricted and any literature, such as the Bible, suggesting the possibility of recovery, was forbidden.

Churches and watchdog groups put up sufficient objection to the law that it was dropped in committee. Two other bills were vetoed by Governor Jerry Brown that would have had universities distributing abortion pills on campus and mandated LGBTIQ training for teachers.

Another case won in the U.S. Supreme Court had wide implications. A new California law forced pro-life pregnancy centers to advertise abortion as an alternative. When it was struck down, attorneys pointed out that if the government could force someone to speak against their will, no one would truly have freedom of speech.

A similar case won before the U.S. Supreme Court involved a Colorado baker, Jack Phillips, who refused to design a cake for a same-sex wedding. The court found that he had been erroneously convicted by a hostile government commission. But to show how persistent the government can be when taken over by unrighteous people, Phillips was immediately baited by a transgender customer and charged again for nearly the same thing. He is now fighting back by suing the government agency for harassment.

These examples show that evil can be driven back if someone cares enough to try. When a cross-dresser shows up at your school or library to read propaganda

to your kindergartener, we need to rally the parents until it is stopped.

When your favorite store allows men in the women's dressing and bathrooms, management should hear from lots of customers. The same applies to athletic gyms or high school sports facilities.

Managers and administrators often

only feel pressure from the wrong side. We need to balance the picture.

Does 'Palestine' Belong in the Book of Joshua?

Adding to the Bible can be risky, even if it is only in the helps. In an effort to assist the reader, some Bibles place section headings into the chapters. When the subject changes, the change may be indicated by a section head.

Dr. Michael L. Brown, guest columnist for OneNewsNow.com, points out that in some recent NASB versions of the Bible, the section headings about Joshua's conquest of Canaan used the word "Palestine" instead. Brown points out that no such nation existed at that time, so this attempt to "modernize" the Bible could lead to a misunderstanding.

This is beside the fact that this recognition of the area by that name is highly offensive to today's Israelis and could be viewed as anti-Semitic.

This small example highlights the great risk in trying to "fix" the Bible by adapting to a more "modern" language. Which modern language will you use, Boston English, Texas English, or Cockney British? The confusion of dozens of new Bibles that we have today demonstrates the difficulty here.

Even a single language is very fluid. Anyone trying to keep up with each new generation will have to continually chase the new expressions. By the time the book is printed, it will be obsolete.

But God had a better plan. All He needed was one perfectly translated copy

in English. It wasn't up to Him to adapt to the ever-changing nuances of the language. He expected us to simply learn it the way He gave it. The number of vocabulary words is roughly equivalent to the vocabulary of a five-and-a-half-year-old child, and the vast majority of the words are commonly known to this day.

About 200 years after the release of the King James, wise leaders of the church predicted that trying to update the Classic English of the Authorized King James might open it to mischief.

they And were right beyond expectations. Those who objected were overruled and a Bible society of "experts" was organized. Satan's plan "B" was kicked into high gear. Having failed to burn all the bibles -and Biblebelievers— during the Inquisition, he was determined to shroud the Bible in doubt. It might take a few decades -but he had the time.

It's a Bigger Battle Than You Think

Someone has described the recent political chaos as a battle for the soul of America. But the political arena is only a skin sore. The infection is much deeper.

Any "soul" that America has is the product of the "souls" of all Americans.

We are shocked when a girl finds a man in her bathroom. But only in the "Christian" west and only in the last 500 years have women been able to expect any kind of protection and respect. Most people in history would be shocked that the locker room is protected.

We are shocked when investigations report thousands molested by hundreds of priests, first in Chile, then in Pennsylvania, then Germany, then Ireland. But U.S. soldiers reported "toy boys" were common among the local "clergy" in Iraq and Afghanistan.

counterfeit church. After all, the pope had been a big help in the campaign to burn all the Bibles.




