Pastor Develops Witnessing Strategy for Muslims

Pastor Brian Kelly, who pastors in New York and operates the 42nd Street Soul Saving Station in the 42nd Street subway station,* witnesses to many Muslims who pass his literature stand. He has found a systematic approach that often gets the Muslim thinking about Jesus and sometimes accepting Him as Saviour.

Kelly begins by telling the Muslim that the Bible is true and can be trusted. The standard response from the Muslim is that the Bible has been corrupted and contains errors. He is surprised when Kelly agrees with him that all the modern Bibles are unreliable, but that God has preserved one Bible that can be trusted: the King James Version.

Kelly then points to the Qur'an, that is considered reliable only in the Arabic language. The Muslim admits that he has not personally studied the original Qur'an, that he relies on the imam to interpret it. Kelly shows that the New Testament in the KJV is much larger than the Qur'an and contains a more complete account of God's will for us. Furthermore, anyone can read and understand it for himself.

If he can convince the Muslim that the Bible is accurate and trustworthy, then he will move the discussion to Jesus. He will try to show the Muslim that the Qur'an talks about Jesus but has incomplete information about Him.

To illustrate, Kelly will show him verses that speak of a loving God quite different than the vengeful, inscrutable Allah of Islam. In fact, Jesus was that loving God who went to the cross and died in our place so we could know for sure that we would have a place in heaven.

This leads to a discussion about the Muslim's lack of assurance that the Islamic rituals will take care of his sin problem. In explaining the reason for the Christian's assurance, Kelly can show that Jesus was more than just a prophet like Islam teaches.

He can prove from this more complete Word of God that Jesus was really God in the flesh. Furthermore, this loving God cared enough for us to come in the flesh and take the punishment for our sins on the cross. That way, we could know for sure we would go to heaven by trusting in His sacrifice for us.

By stressing the contrast between the Christian assurance of a loving relationship with Jesus and the uncertain rituals of Islam, Kelly demonstrates how faith in Jesus and the Bible is a better path to heaven.

Even if the Muslim does not accept Christ at the time, Kelly has given him much to think about. By showing that the Bible is more complete and trustworthy and that Jesus paid for our sins and purchased assurance of heaven, he holds out a new kind of hope that the average Muslim has not encountered in Islam.

Kelly makes sure that the Muslim has a handful of tracts to leave with, such as *Allah Had No Son, Men of Peace?* and *Unforgiven*.

He also gives them the Crusaders Comics, *Sabotage* to help them understand about the KJV, and *The Prophet* on the origins of Islam. Other tracts such as *Creator or Liar, Love Story*, and *The Word Became Flesh* help them understand about Jesus.

Using this approach, Kelly has led a couple of Muslims to Christ on the spot and others have visited his church to learn more. Only eternity will tell how many more have responded later to Kelly's witness.

Kelly's ministry depends heavily on others for donations of tracts and literature. Ever Wanted to ‘Kill Somebody’?

How often have we wanted revenge and deserved a rebuke from the Lord? So wouldn't it be helpful to know what Jesus said when He rebuked the disciples for wanting to “kill somebody?”

In Luke 9, we see the disciples wanting to call down fire from heaven on some hostile Samaritans. Jesus quickly vetoed the idea and told them why. If you have one of the modern bibles, the “why” may be missing. But with a KJV, His message is clear what we should do, instead, when we want to strike back in anger.

Let's compare Luke 9:54-56 in the most popular modern version and the KJV:

NIV—*When the disciples James and John saw this, they asked, “Lord, do you want us to call fire down from heaven to destroy them?” But Jesus turned and rebuked them, and they went to another village.*

KJV—*And when his disciples James and John saw this, they said, Lord, wilt thou that we command fire to come down from heaven, and consume them, even as Elias did? But he turned, and rebuked them, and said, Ye know not what manner of spirit ye are of. For the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them. And they went to another village.*

Jesus made it clear that our job is to save the unbeliever, not kill him! We must fit into Christ's agenda and try to woo them into the kingdom.

How sad that the modern Bible version that has become the most popular and used in major denominational literature has this defect. Most other new versions also omit this important teaching by Jesus Himself.

So, if you have one of these defective Bible versions, you need to trade it in for a complete one.

If you want more information, Chick Publications has several helpful books on this problem. Author Chick Salliby, in his book, *If The Foundations Be Destroyed*, lists over 150 places where the NIV has words missing or changed. Salliby asks, “What does the NIV have against Jesus?” He lists several dozen places where the NIV omits or changes names and titles of Jesus.

Salliby says that the NIV translators cannot carry all of the blame. They were working from defective manuscripts. Another author, David W. Daniels has written two books detailing the history of these polluted manuscripts: *Answers To Your Bible Version Questions* and *Did the Catholic Church Give Us the Bible?*

Daniels shows how the KJV is based on a mountain of preserved manuscripts kept free from corruption, while the few manuscripts behind the NIV and other modern versions come from a polluted stream.

When you look at the historical evidence, it is no mystery why the modern bibles are so chopped up.

A Vacation—From Soul Winning?

Is a vacation also a break from soul winning? Serious Bible believers know that there is nothing about that in the great commission. So how do you do it? Here is how one vacation was turned into a “mini-mission trip:”

We took Chick tracts (*This Was Your Life* in Spanish) on vacation to Mexico,

Playa del Carmen & Cozumel. We gave them out to all the shop workers as I shopped and only two refused. Gave out 900 tracts. Many thanked me. After going a few blocks, I'd stop and look back and everyone was sitting outside his shop, studying his Chick tract.

Maybe God has planted you in that church for the purpose of telling the others in your church family that you got saved from reading a tract and that they should pass out tracts, too. This is important because a lot of young pastors are being taught in seminary: "Don't bother to pass out tracts. They don't work anymore."

We know that that is not true. But, nonetheless, that is what they are being taught. Someone needs to stand up in your church and say, "Of course they work. That is how I got saved."

Otherwise, many Christians know that they should spend hours sitting with unbelievers and sharing the gospel, but they either don't have time or don't know how. If they knew that tracts still work, they would realize that there really is something they can do.

If you are one of those people, you need to be telling people in your church that that is how you got saved. Maybe that is why God planted you there, to "encourage the brethren" who really want to witness but do not know how easy it can be with a gospel tract.

So, be bold in sharing your testimony with other Christians. And in the process, you can hand them a tract and challenge them to pass it on to an unbeliever or plant it somewhere in their travels.

Step 3: Once personal issues have been identified and acknowledged, focus on improving family relationships. Family ties, especially from a healthy, loving and spiritual family, are much stronger than the *conditional* love that exists in the Watchtower. If they see unconditional love in the family, it will be easier to abandon the conditional love based on rules and regulations in the Watchtower.

Note: Cult groups exploit the human need for association, belonging, and for family. This is especially true for those who are starving for attention, love and acceptance. The Watchtower will capitalize on those needs where one's family is *perceived* to have failed.

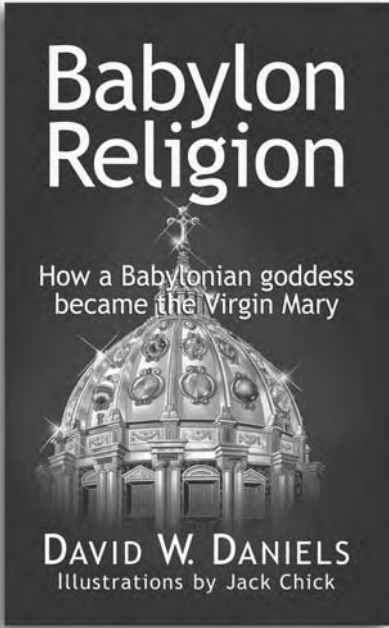
Step 4: Love the family member unconditionally. The Watchtower cult loves *conditionally* depending on how hard the member works for the organization. He will soon learn that the Watchtower fails to live up to its promises. Whatever your family member enjoyed before being recruited into the Watchtower, give him that same kind of love. This will make him homesick for your affection he once held dear.

Step 5: After trust has been re-established, use the strategies outlined in *Winning The Witnesses* that are designed to plant seeds of doubt in the minds of the Jehovah's Witnesses. Be sure you are prepared to patiently and prayerfully introduce these thoughts. Over time, you will learn the Watchtower language that he uses. You will learn how to introduce the idea that the Watchtower is not what it claims to be: inspired of God. Give him time to think about this concept. Don't try to rush the process.

Remember: the Jehovah's Witnesses have surrendered their identities to the Watchtower. Your goal is to re-orient the person back to his pre-cult identity —the place where rigid rules are not required for acceptance. This is why it is important to take care of family issues before you begin. (Refer to step two)

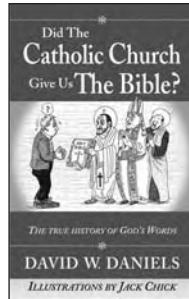

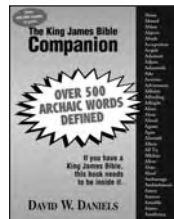

have been helpful in focusing our attention on the evils of abortion and homosexuality. However, sugar-coated poison is still poison. Satan's lies are always mixed with an element of truth.

The history of nations that have embraced Vatican teachings is not pretty. In the Latin American countries, Catholic idolatrous rituals have bred poverty, corruption and political turmoil while the U.S. prospered under the widespread preaching of biblical righteousness.

Both began as virgin territories with rich resources of forests, minerals and oil but religious freedom in one and spiritual bondage in the other achieved very different results. There would be no immigration woes today had righteousness reigned on both continents. Truly, "Righteousness exalteth a nation but sin is a reproach to any people" (Proverbs 14:34).

For a thousand years, known as the "dark ages," the Vatican held the Western World in spiritual darkness. Ignorance and superstition gripped the people. Corrupt popes terrorized kings and plowmen alike. Any who objected had to flee to the caves to avoid being burned as heretics.

Rome's bonds were broken when God released the printing press technology so the Bible could be published for the common man. Satan had to come up with a new strategy for his prostitute "church." Ecumenism was born. The lie that all religions essentially worship the same god began to spread. The Vatican held an "Ecumenical Council" known as "Vatican II." Plans were drafted to bring together the Protestants, Muslims, Jews, Hindus, etc. to pray together for world "peace and justice."

On the political front, the Jesuits have worked for centuries to infiltrate high levels of government to control the levers of power from behind the scenes. Their machinations have gotten them thrown out of several dozen countries in the

past. The new strategy fit their method of operation well.

We see it in operation now with the infiltration around President Bush. He does not go along with all their agenda, but in many ways he is duped. In a recent speech he repeated the pope's position on Islam, that Muslims and Christians both worship the same God. In an interview with ETWN, the reporter asked what he saw when he looked into the eyes of Pope Benedict. "God," President Bush replied.

It is also significant that Benedict chose to speak to the UN while in the U.S. His ecumenical vision includes more than the spiritual. He spoke of the "international community" as a family that needed to work together for the good of each member. But we know from the Bible that any attempt by man to create an "international community" will only result in the introduction of the anti-Christ. Had any of the Fathers of the Reformation been asked what they saw in the eyes of the pope, they would no doubt have said "Anti-Christ!"

Evil will continue to rise in the world until the nations will, in desperation, welcome a world leader who will promise a solution. But that solution will turn out to be world slavery to an even greater evil.

We must pray for our leaders that we may continue to have the peace and freedom to share the gospel. But the Bible assures us that persecution will come and that we need to work "while it is day."

Archbishop Says Muslim Law in Britain ‘Unavoidable’

As the Muslim population grows in the Western World, the clash of cultures is becoming more obvious. The Archbishop of Canterbury, Dr. Rowan Williams, recently suggested that it was “unavoidable” that some aspects of Muslim Sharia law would be adopted in Britain. Sharia is government law based on the Qur’an.

British Prime Minister Gordon Brown was quick to chastise Williams. “Our general position is that sharia law cannot be used as a justification for committing breaches of English law,” Brown’s office countered.

For a glimpse of how English laws and Sharia laws collide, one need only look at nations under strict Islamic law. Iran, Saudi Arabia, and Egypt, are examples where Sharia law condones: forced marriages, multiple wives, 99 lashes for adultery, and execution by family members for leaving Islam.

Recently in Scotland, a Muslim restaurant owner was about to lose his license for speeding. He pleaded undue hardship because his two wives lived in different towns and he had to spend every other night with them. An exemption was granted.

In February, the British government cleared the way for husbands of multiple wives to claim welfare benefits for all their partners. Though bigamy is outlawed, Muslim men have never been prosecuted who brought more than one wife when they immigrated. The government estimates there are

at least 1000 polygamous marriages in Britain. Authorities are also having to deal with honor killings and forced marriages, allowable in Islam, but contrary to Western laws.

It is increasingly obvious that Islamic law and laws based on biblical morality are miles apart. Another Muslim practice is called Mutaah or Urfi, a short-term, temporary “marriage” that can last for a few weeks, a few days or even hours. To Westerners this looks too much like prostitution but it is considered legal in Islam.

Western courts are struggling in other ways with this “culture shock.” In France, retired actress Brigitte Bardot is facing a fine of thousands of Euros for publicly

saying that the Muslim community is “destroying our country and imposing its acts.” She is being charged with “inciting racial hatred” and has already been fined four other times for speaking out against Muslim practices.

Christians must not be afraid to speak out against Islam. Would you rather be “politically incorrect” or see your daughter in a “short-term marriage” to a Muslim immigrant.

Muslim leaders have lost their fear of sending people to the U.S. They no longer worry that they will be won to Christ.

Soul winners, they need to begin worrying again!



“I am fed up with being under the thumb of this population [Muslim immigrants] which is destroying us, destroying our country and imposing its acts,” Bardot said.

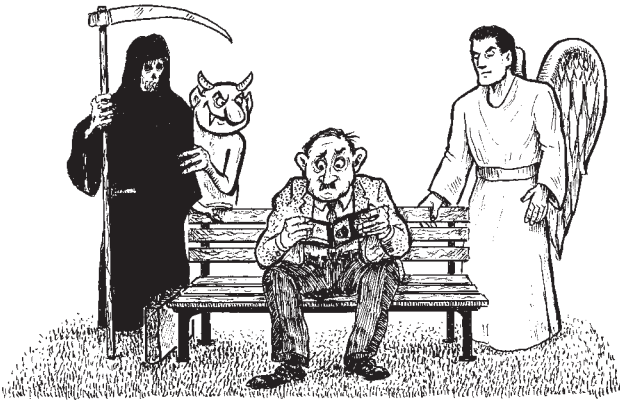
