targeted much of the sinful foolishness in our culture.

The modern breakup of the Biblically based family has had huge implications for the culture. Most prison inmates come from dysfunctional families. 
#3 Many today are dying from the virus in "retirement homes" because there is no loving family to care for them safely at home.



in love, not hate. Hatred would be ignoring the countless unsaved going to hell and the lake of fire. Love is offering God's way out, through faith in the shed blood of His only begotten Son. Revolutions Rarely Benefit Christians

There is much talk today about revolution. Few revolutions bode well for Christians. Historically, a few may have been beneficial such as the American Revolution that established the United States against British tyranny.

It is becoming increasingly obvious that today's controversy is far deeper than just the superficial political parties. Leaders are making no effort to hide the influence of godless Marxism. The foundation has been laid for quite a few decades with the broad teaching of evolution that discredits the Bible and the Creator.

Since God is no longer in the equation, man is alone in the universe to chart his own course toward utopia. But this leaves man to simply "do that which [is] right in his own eyes" leading to chaos and everyone competing for leadership and government power.

Marxists know that the chaos must get bad enough for the general public to accept the domination of a government oppressive enough to quell the chaos. The standard model in the takeover of countries by Marxist regimes has been to pit the supposed "oppressed" against imagined or real "oppressors".

This is where the church gets caught in the crossfire. Satan's counterfeit church, headquartered in the Vatican, has a long bloody history of oppression. They have done it under the false banner of Christianity and so it is easy for the Marxist agitators to paint even the true Bible-believing Christians with the same brush.

Christians are increasingly labeled as the oppressors for declaring God's perspective against poor sinners involved in sodomy, pride, corruption, adultery, etc. Through the non-discrimination laws, legal standing is given to these sins that are highly destructive to the culture.

THE POOR REVOLUTIONIST

Non-discrimination laws are designed to shut down debate and any effort to preach the gospel. Marxist countries such as China, Cuba, Russia, and Venezuela are prime examples of how effective (and destructive) this strategy is.

So far America and much of the Western World have been protected by freedoms guaranteed by constitutions installed by founders who foresaw the danger. But Marxism ignores these constitutions and has been rapidly gaining ground here in our increasingly godless culture.

Nowhere is this more apparent than in Europe. One of our basic constitutional guarantees has been the freedom of speech. In Marxist countries where this is prohibited, preaching of the gospel can be very dangerous.

Christians in Scotland are currently raising the alarm over a bill that has been proposed. It is called the Hate Crime and Public Order Bill. Prosecution of hate crimes has customarily been confined to actual acts of physical aggression. This bill proposes to prosecute anyone on a charge of simply "stirring up hatred."

When you consider the Marxist strategy of highlighting the oppressed, anyone who is offended by speech can call down the authorities. That is the reason that, in the universities, the term microaggression has been invented. Students are taught that any attitude toward them that makes them uncomfortable can be labeled as aggression, and outlawed.

Bold preachers in England are under increasing pressure from the government when someone complains of being offended by their Biblical message. In America, flower shops and cake bakers have been charged and fined when they refused to contribute their talents to ceremonies that violate their Christian consciences. Pastors in Canada, who reference certain scriptures in their messages, run the risk of violating the law.

Unless the Lord intervenes and America bows in repentance and forsakes our sin, the rioters in our streets could very easily turn their attention to the Bible-believing churches and all efforts to get the gospel out, such as tract distribution.

Soul winners, we really need to get the gospel out while we still have time.

With Schools Closed, Satan's Attack is Closer to Home

Satan never sleeps, particularly in his campaign to destroy children. The COVID-19 virus put a lid on the drag queen story hours at the now-closed libraries. Closed schools have rescued the innocence of our youngsters from the titillations of sex-ed curricula —for a while.

But with the children confined at home, the attack is now focused there. Recent headlines tell the story: "Cartoon Network Celebrates 'Pride Month," "Disney Celebrates Pride Month, Donates \$100K to GLSEN (Gay, Lesbian, Straight Education Network)", "Netflix Introduces Transgender Child" and "Children's TV Network Nickelodeon: Celebrating Pride ... This Month and Every Month"

When they approach puberty, things get darker. One Wall Street journalist,

Abigail Shrier, was so shocked when she found enough information for a book: "Irreversible Damage: The Transgender Craze Seducing Our Daughters." Shrier was first alerted by a distraught mom trying to get the attention of a journalist who would investigate a craze of teen girls deciding in mass to convert to boys.

Even without the help of the closed schools, the girls were joining up on social media where the idea was fermenting. Shrier's first article flushed out thousands of parents all over the country who had detected the attack.

Shrier's book was born after interviewing dozens of doctors who outlined a horror story. The puberty blockers given these children arrest all

New Danish Bible Illustrates Fallacy of Modern Bibles

A new Danish Bible has been attacked for removing the word "Israel" from many verses. When accused of being anti-Semitic, the Danish Bible Society explained that the intent was to help a secular reader who might confuse the Israel in the Bible with the present nation of Israel.

This is a classic example of people posing as translators, who introduce their own interpretation into the scripture. A true translator looks for an exact word in the new language to match the one in the old language. Obviously, that's not always possible, but he still attempts to duplicate the same concept in the new language that was intended by the writer in the previous language.

Although the Danish Bible Society made a few of the changes in the Old Testament, the majority were in the New Testament. Luke 4:25 is an example of how convoluted such an interpretation can become. In the KJV it reads: "...many widows were in Israel in the days of Elias..." In the new Danish Contemporary Bible that is changed to: "...many Jewish widows in the time of Prophet Elijah."

The word "Jewish" was not in use in Elijah's time, and he was a prophet in the northern kingdom, not in Judah where the word "Jewish" eventually originated. And, since this is part of a point that Jesus was making, He looks confused in His knowledge of history.

"Israel" appears in over 60 places in the Greek manuscripts used by the Danes but only two remain unchanged in the DCB. Other examples include Matt. 2:21 "and he arose, and took the young child and his mother, and came into the land of Israel." This is changed to "came home." Several times "God of Israel" is simply replaced with "God."

This is another example of translation purity being sacrificed in an attempt to accommodate the reader. If this distortion goes on for several generations of "translations," then the original meaning can be completely lost. The only safe way for a reader with limited knowledge of the Bible to not be led astray, is to diligently teach him to understand a faithful translation.

In pages 129-133 of his new book, *New King James: The Bridge Bible*, author David W. Daniels cites an incident where one man failed to adequately teach his son from the preserved English Bible, the King James. This resulted in the serious distortion of many Bibles later marketed by Bible publishers.

Bible publisher Sam Moore had gifted his 11-year-old son with a beautiful, leatherbound, King James Bible. Trying to read it on his own, he gave up and returned it to his dad and asked, "Dad, with all the Bibles you publish, do you make one I can understand?"

Moore was not convicted for failure to teach his son to read the classic English of the King James. Instead, as head of the Thomas Nelson Bible publishers, he was already responsible for a growing variety of Bibles that posed as translations but were really man's interpretations.


Moore went on to produce more Bibles laden with men's ideas, including the New King James, falsely advertised as just an update to the King James with no changes in original meanings. Daniels proves that this was false advertising because the New King James contains changes in meanings that affect fundamental doctrines.

These changes are not in line with the historical meanings of Greek and Hebrew words as we see in the King James Bible. Instead, it reflects the changed meanings we find in modern Bibles.

The bottom line is that there is one faithful, accurate English translation today, the KJV, and this Danish Bible is just another example of the dozens that seriously depart from this time-honored, ministry-proven Bible.

the time of this writing is able to return to the island of Samar. He faces opposition from the local priest and will appreciate your prayers.

In Israel, Missionary Andrew Lewis is facing much of the same opposition that Jesus faced. Local rabbis are attacking him in local papers, and even organizing pickets on the street to protest Lewis' missionary work. But he continues to distribute Chick tracts in all the ways allowed by Israeli law. He is preparing to use special Hebrew-English editions of Chick tracts that contain two tracts printed in a single booklet, with Hebrew on top and English on the bottom. physical sexual development eliminating normal sexual function and pleasure. They also attack the brain, often magnifying any emotional instability such as depression, bipolar or autism.

In fact, the use is so new that there is little evidence of the long-term side effects. Doctors told Shrier that when they attend conferences held to inform them of new drugs, there is usually an effort to describe long-term effects. That information is missing in the puberty blocker presentations. Doctors foresee huge lawsuits when the evidence surfaces.

One current lawsuit is being brought by Keira Bell in England. As a child, Keira walked into Tavistock clinic and declared that she wanted to be a boy. The staff rolled out the red carpet. Although she had started her periods, they gave her no psychological evaluation or counseling, but prescribed puberty blockers.

Now 23, she looks back at that as the beginning of a ruined life. Her developing womanhood halted. "I had symptoms similar to the menopause when a woman's hormones drop. I had hot flushes, I found it difficult to sleep, my sex drive disappeared. I was given calcium tablets because my bones weakened. My female hormones had been flushing through my body and, suddenly, a curtain came down on them." It felt awful, she says.

Keira says the lawsuit against the clinic

is just the start. She is on a mission to help parents and children avoid the trap. She went on through painful body-altering surgeries and now says, "I am living in a world where I don't fit in as male or as female. I am stuck between two sexes."

For Keira Bell, it is too late. She is already scarred and mutilated for life. But Shrier discovered that there are well over 50 "gender clinics" in the U.S. in addition to Planned Parenthood, a major dispenser of hormone blockers.

We have not yet achieved enough outrage to stop the spilling of hundreds of gallons of innocent blood in abortion clinics. And when will we rise up and end this mutilation of our children?

We certainly can start by pushing the stop button on the remote when Netflix and Disney try to pump fantasies into our children's minds about the glories of the transgender lifestyle. In today's hostile world, parents must be on guard and teach their children defense tactics against Satan's indoctrination by the media, social media, friends, and even teachers.

The first was from Bristol in the UK, regarding a person who called the police because she was angered when our gospel tract, *Home Alone?*, arrived in her door slot. I tell about that in this Battle Cry issue.

The second was from Mr. Andrew Whalen of Newsweek magazine, probably triggered by the gospel tract, *The Poor Revolutionist*, and expanding to other issues from there.

Both were from people who showed no signs of being Christian. What an opportunity! They asked specific questions, and I prayed and gave specific answers. But I didn't stop there. At every place where I could put the gospel in, I did, including giving links to books or tracts that were pertinent.

Remember: I didn't seek after them. They came to me! Then, because I believe in being open with our Chick family and the world, I placed both the questions and the answers, word for word, on our Chick Facebook page for all to see for themselves. If a reporter didn't put what I actually said, it would show up when people compared the raw data to the article.

But the UK article was fair, and the small quotes that were inserted were to the point and my own words. We will see what happens with the Newsweek article. As of this time I have not seen the result.

In addition, I asked fellow Christians to pray for these people. What could be a better opportunity than that?

- 1) **Pray for opportunities!** We have no idea when they'll come. But when they do:
- 2) **Be prepared for opportunities!** That's why I read my Bible and pray daily, and I keep a supply of Chick tracts on me at all times outside the house.

Brothers and Sisters, there are so many opportunities, and God has selected us to be His messengers. Let's get that message out with a smile on our face. As they used to say, "Run to the roar!"


