Legalized Abduction: Children At Risk Across America

Alyssa Johnson, a mother from Oregon, hasn't seen her daughter in years. Not because of a crime, custody battle, or court order — but because of Oregon laws that let minors be removed from their parents and placed in host homes or foster programs without parental consent.

Under ORS 419B.150 and 419B.152, if a child tells a teacher, counselor, or youth worker they feel "unsafe" at home, they can be taken into state custody immediately — no court order, no investigation, no due process. "Unsafe" doesn't mean abuse. It can be as simple as parents not using preferred pronouns or requiring homework before screen time.



Once classified as an "unaccompanied youth," a child gains access to state-backed programs offering housing, stipends, and medical interventions — including gender transition services — while parents are cut out. Johnson calls it "legalized abduction," describing it as a system that profits from keeping

Equipping Kids for Battle

This school year, nearly 100,000 students in 34 states will step out of their classrooms to hear God's word in LifeWise Academy's released time Bible programs. Training the Next Generation

Many see a revival starting to brew. But how do we ensure this is a lasting revival, and not just a mirror of King Josiah's reign?

King Josiah enforced the rule of law and restored the teaching of God's word, and the people seemed to return to God —but Jeremiah reveals in chapter 3, verse 10: "Judah hath not turned unto me with her whole heart, but feignedly (in appearance only), saith the LORD." We have a chance to prevent this outcome.

Drive the Word Deep

We have an opportunity to drive the word of God and revival deep into our nation. How? We must raise leaders from our youth to know the word of God, and equip them to raise the next generation, and the next after that.

It is not enough to raise responsible adults. We must raise godly parents, pastors, politicians, and leaders. We must model the value of teaching —to reprove, rebuke, and exhort— the next generation with the literal word of God "with all longsuffering (enduring wrong

Prayer Made Illegal in the West

In Quebec, Canada, Premier François Legault's government is getting ready to make it **illegal to pray in public.** Why? Because officials don't like seeing Muslims pray in the streets at protests. But their ban won't just silence Muslims — it will also gag Christians.

Jean-François Roberge, Minister for Secularism, admitted the government is "uneasy" with public prayer. So **instead of defending freedom, they want to erase it.**

Civil liberty groups pushed back, warning that the action tramples religious freedom. The Canadian Civil Liberties Association stressed that "public spaces belong to everyone" and their diverse beliefs.

Cardus, a Christian think tank, reminded the government that nearly 65% of Quebec's people still call themselves Christian. The group pointed out that churches hold communities together. Shut them down, and you rip out the heart of society.

But Quebec's leaders don't care. Their goal is simple: **silence prayer**, **silence faith.** Australia: Prayer = Crime

Across the world in New South Wales, Australia, lawmakers have also taken the mask off. The Conversion Practices Ban Act 2024 says that if you pray with someone who wants help to live by God's word about sex or gender, you've broken the law.

Read that again: helping someone follow the Bible is now illegal.

Attorney General Michael Daley was blunt: "If it's an unlawful prayer, then it's not a lawful prayer." Translation: the government decides which prayers are allowed.

Lyle Shelton of Family First warned: "If a mum, dad, pastor, or friend prays with someone who asks for help to follow God's word, they could face sanction. That is extraordinary overreach." The measure is one step away from criminalizing voluntary, faith-based conversations between friends, pastors, and family members.

Shelton has vowed to push for legislation restoring the right to pray freely. "Prayer has always been about change — change in circumstances,

children in care while branding parents as the problem.

She has begged for answers, only to be met with silence. Agencies refuse to open a missing person report, enforce a return home, or even confirm if they know her daughter's whereabouts. And it's all legal.

Strangers Allowed to Claim Custody

In California, lawmakers are pushing Assembly Bill 495, the Family Preparedness Plan Act of 2025. It expands the definition of a "caregiver" to include "any adult with a mentoring relationship" with a child. Nearly any adult could present a signed affidavit to a school and gain custody rights — no background check, no parental notification.

Pastor Jack Hibbs of Calvary Chapel Chino Hills is urging Christians to take the threat seriously. "There's no requirement in the bill for the school to call you, to ask you if it's OK if someone takes your daughter out of school,"

Hibbs warned. "It 100 percent strips parents of their parental rights."

The bill would even allow these "caregivers" to authorize medical treatment, including immunizations, physical exams, or gender transitions. Hibbs has gone so far as to warn his congregation that if AB 495 passes, parents may have no choice but to "pack up and get out" of California.

Mandatory Mental Health Screening

In Illinois, Governor J.B. Pritzker recently signed SB 1560, a law requiring mandatory mental health screening of all public school students every year starting in third grade.

This creates a wide-open door for schools, bureaucrats, and pharmaceutical companies to label children, collect sensitive data, and funnel them into lifelong medical dependency.

Abigail Shrier, author of *Irreversible Damage*, called the law "a disastrous policy that will do vastly more harm than good." Harvard-trained psychiatrist Dr. Peter Breggin warned it

without retaliation) and doctrine." "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect (fully equipped), throughly furnished unto all good works" (2 Timothy 3:16-17).

Raise Real Men of God

We must reach **wandering** young men and train **genuine** men of God. "True Masculinity" and "Real Men" are current buzzwords that are impossible without God.

We must teach what a real man of God looks like from scripture, bearing the fruit of the Spirit: "love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law" (Galatians 5:22-23).

I would further encourage aligning with the Apostle Paul's qualifications of a bishop: "the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach; not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre (money or gain); but patient, not a brawler, not covetous; one that ruleth well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity" (1 Timothy 3:2-4).

We must teach these young men to prepare for whatever calling the Lord may place on their lives. "For the eyes of

would lead to the "mass medicalization of children" and create "a storehouse of distorted psychiatric data and diagnoses that can ruin their lives."

Parents can technically opt out — for now. But as laws normalize, exemptions often erode until they disappear.

A Disastrous National Trend

What begins on the West Coast often spreads nationwide. Activist groups and government agencies are testing boundaries, and unless parents speak up, push back, and defend their God-

given role, these policies will become permanent.

The greatest safeguard for children is still the word of God. We must teach them scripture, ground them in the gospel, and model daily faithfulness to Christ. Filling their hearts with truth through solid biblical literature — like Chick gospel tracts and comics can plant seeds of faith in a world determined to confuse them.

Now is the time for Christian parents to stay alert, stay involved, and stand firm. Because if the state can take away your parental rights today, it may claim your child tomorrow.

after discovering they were expected to share locker rooms with biological boys.

Instead of restoring modesty and privacy, the school district forced girls to file either a **religious exemption** or a **mental health accommodation** if they want to stay decent.

Parents pushed back, saying their daughters aren't "sick" or "anxious" — they just deserve privacy. Board member Dr. Joseph Komrosky promised to keep fighting for their innocence and safety.

This is exactly why Bible-based programs are so vital. Children facing situations like this need a **firm foundation in God's word** — a moral compass strong enough to stand against

cultural confusion, peer pressure, and worldly lies.

Indoctrination Without Escape

In Washington State, the assault goes even further. SB 5462 now requires LGBTQ "inclusive" curriculum in every subject, every grade — with no opt-out. Unlike comprehensive sex-ed laws where parents could excuse their children, this law systematizes ideology across math, history, and beyond.

Parents are left with a stark choice: accept what undermines Biblical teaching or remove their children entirely. Even the Supreme Court's affirmation of parental rights is conveniently sidestepped by making "inclusion" part of the overall

change in hearts, change in lives," he said. But until then, **change itself has been outlawed**. This is not just anti-Christian. It is **anti-God**.

UK: Arrested for Silent Prayer

Meanwhile, in Britain, the war on prayer is chilling. Isabel Vaughan-Spruce, director of March for Life UK, has been **arrested twice** for silently praying outside an abortion clinic. Both times, police dropped the charges and even paid her £13,000 in damages for wrongful treatment.

Now, they've come after her a third time. Why? Because prayer — even silent prayer — terrifies a system that hates God.

"Despite being fully vindicated multiple times, I am still being harassed by police for silently praying in that area," Vaughan-Spruce said. "Silent prayer cannot possibly be a crime — everyone has the right to freedom of thought."

Others are being targeted too. A Catholic priest was charged for holding

a sign that said, "Praying for freedom of speech." Another woman was convicted just for offering to talk with women near a clinic.

This is what happens when a nation turns its back on God. Even **thoughts** are policed.

Bible believers, What Will You Do?

Do you see it? This is no accident. It is the same spirit of Antichrist moving through every nation: **shut down prayer**, **silence the gospel**, **stop souls from finding Christ**.

The freedom to pray is not "optional." It is the lifeblood of the Christian walk. If we let governments tell us when, where, or how we can pray, we have already surrendered to their false gods of tolerance.

Now is the time to stand. Pray boldly. Preach publicly. Hand out tracts. Share Christ everywhere you can — before it's too late.

The world wants prayer gone. God wants His people on their knees. Which side will you choose?

curriculum design.

This isn't education. It's indoctrination. It is a direct attack on God's design and the family's authority to raise children in truth. Families who don't agree will have to leave the system entirely—or watch their children be steeped in content that undermines Biblical teaching on sex, identity, and morality.

Bible Truths Instilled

Released time programs put tens of thousands of students in front of God's word weekly. Kids learn His design for life, and return equipped to live faithfully in their classrooms and communities.

They hear truths like Genesis 1:27—"male and female created He them"—the foundation of God's creation. They learn right from wrong. They develop the strength to stand firm in the classroom, in sports, in conversations with friends, and in the halls of culture.

Every new program, every hour engaged in learning the Bible is another opportunity to **equip kids in the battle** for Christ.

Training Up the Next Generation

Released time alone isn't enough. Children need constant exposure to scripture at home. Chick tracts and comics are perfect tools for this. They are simple, engaging, full of God's truth, and easy for kids to carry wherever they go. the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him" (2 Chronicles 16:9).

Raise Little Leaders from Our Youth

We must inspire young fathers to invest God's word in their children by any means necessary, raising them from infancy to be the leaders of tomorrow.

"And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up" (Deuteronomy 6:7). Repetition is key.

"Only take heed to thyself, and keep

thy soul diligently... teach them thy sons, and thy sons' sons" (Deuteronomy 4:9).

A Revival with Roots

The revival we seek needs roots that sink deep by the river of God's word. If we fail in this mission, this revival will mirror Josiah's —where God ultimately judged Judah because their hearts weren't truly committed to God.

I want a revival my children and grandchildren can live under, where the depth of Biblical foundation prevents the next apostasy from bringing worse persecution than we have already seen. It starts with our young men. It starts with the youth. We must all train our children to train their children, to carry the torch until Christ's return.

Mission Possible: Reaching the Highways and Prisons of America

For over 50 years, Mission Possible — led faithfully by Director Jo Anna Woody — has pressed into some of America's most forgotten mission fields. From prison cells to the endless highways that cut across the nation, this ministry has carried Chick tracts, Bibles, and Christian literature into places starved for light, pushing back the darkness with the gospel.

Highways and Hedges Ministry

Truckers spend long hours in isolation, often far from their families and communities. That's why Mission Possible's "highways and hedges" outreach has become a lifeline. These men and women eagerly receive Bibles, gospel tracts, and solid Christian books — material that fills the long stretches of time on the road and points them toward Christ.

One testimony shared with Jo Anna tells the story of a young, 25-year-old Spanish-speaking trucker. When he was given a large-print Spanish Bible by a "highways and hedges" minister, he was so moved with gratitude he tried to give \$19 in return. Even after being told the gift was free, he insisted on contributing. Before the encounter ended, he was also handed a copy of Lo Unico Cosa (One Thing You Can't Do in Heaven by Mark Cahill), a pack of Spanish Chick tracts, and the Rev de Reves (King of Kings) comic book. He drove away equipped to grow in Christ — and armed with tools to share Christ with others.

The minister writes, "Please tell the Mission Possible donors that there are many truckers carrying the gospel all across North America (Mexico, USA, and Canada)... This would not happen were it not for their generosity."

The Mission Field Behind Bars

Prisons remain another fertile mission field. Chaplains often write to Mission Possible with stories of inmates responding with joy over the gospel literature provided to them. One chaplain recently shared an extraordinary opportunity: the law librarian at his facility cleared out an entire bookcase and asked him to keep it stocked with Bibles, tracts, and Christian materials.

"I was shocked," he wrote. "This has never happened at another facility. The inmates devour the reading materials. They have so much time on their hands." Now he keeps that library shelf full of Bibles, Chick tracts, and Christian books provided through Mission Possible.

Inmates who may never set foot in a church are **encountering Christ through a tract or Bible placed in their hands at just the right moment**.

Decades of Faithful Service

Since January, Mission Possible has already distributed:

- 2,096 Bibles
- 3.472 Chick comic books
- 43,905 Chick tracts
- 363 books and commentaries
- 500 Mark Cahill books

Each of these resources represents a gospel seed sown — in a prison cell, a truck cab, or a lonely corner of America.

For half a century, Mission Possible has faithfully supported chaplains, encouraged truckers, and equipped ordinary Christians to share Christ with those around them. Chick tracts, in particular, have been central to this mission, providing clear, simple gospel messages that reach hearts in a way few other tools can.

Missions Fund Report

Because so many of you have been giving to buy Chick tracts for missionaries, a tremendous amount has been happening since the last Battle Cry newsletter.

We encourage you to subscribe to the Chick email newsletter, so you can receive weekly updates on Mission Fund projects. Meanwhile, here is a brief review of what has happened since the last printed Battle Cry.

Azores (Portugal)

Missionary Brian Green of Seed for the Cities is going back to the Azores. They descended on these islands in June with a team that covered the island with Chick tracts and had eight services during 21 days, seeing many people saved. Now, thanks to your giving, they are going back with another 20,000 Chick tracts. There are still many who need Jesus!

Netherlands

Missionary Stan Kamps has been faithfully distributing the tracts you gave him in April. He reported that

the church is growing! He wrote, "We have continued with mass distribution in the greater Amsterdam area and other parts of the Netherlands as well. With fewer people out and about we have been delivering them house to house and on mass apartment blocks as here we will have access to the mail boxes . . . this year's events seem to be waking them up!"

Thanks to your giving, we just shipped him another 100,000 Chick tracts, which include 30,000 for the Syrian church in Almere.

Ivory Coast

Veteran missionary Dan Cuthbertson is on a short furlough but is loading a container to go back to Ivory Coast with him, and he asked for 80,000 Chick tracts to go in that container. Your giving made that possible, and they were shipped to him in early September. He wrote that they are currently working in church plants in the port city of San Pedro and a nearby village. They are also helping with eight other church plants further north.

Mexico

Missionary Paul Buskager is planning another big outreach in Mexicali, a city of 3,000,000 people. you gave, we were able to supply the 277,000 Chick tracts that he needs for this outreach. They pass out the tracts all over the city, and have evening evangelistic services.

Also in Mexico, we continue to work toward completion of the 2.4 million tract project for Missionary Joe Hendrigsman in Oaxaca. We have now completed the printing of more than half this project, with just 800,000 tracts to go. We have made some shipments, and Hendrigsman is already using the first ones. He wrote:

"We have been able to send some to the border of Chiapas and Guatemala. Some even went into Guatemala. We have sent some to the states of Puebla and Vera Cruz. We have received permission to give each student in the municipality of San Andres Paxtlan a Bible and they will each get two different titles of Chick tracts. This will be done in November, I just received a call for tracts for the state of Hidalgo. I will send them in the next

United Kingdom

We continue to supply the evangelists of Cross Mission in the Kingdom. These Korean believers have come to the country that gave us our English Bible (the KJV) to minister to Brits who don't know the Lord, and also to the many Muslims that have come here. Thanks to your giving, another 30,000 Chick tracts were just delivered. In addition, we are just completing printing for a shipment of 200,000 more. You are making an impact here.

Thailand

Missionary Anthony Reitberg, a veteran missionary who has spent 23 years in Thailand, preaches on the streets and passes out the Chick tracts that you provide to him. You just sent him 8,000 more.

Also in Thailand, tens of thousands more Chick tracts have gone to the workers connected with Missionary Pat Caspary. They work not only among the Thai people, but also the refugees from the terrible war in Burma, where the troops are bombing their own civilians. They receive rice, help and Chick tracts. The children also are taught, and learn about Jesus' love for them.

We are continuing to print the Chick tracts to fill the next container to the Philippines. It will hold 2.4 million Chick tracts. The tracts from the last container (number 6) are going all over the country, bringing people face to face with their need of Jesus. See the pictures below.

Brazil

Missionary Dave Darling (Campaigns For Christ) is planning an outreach in Brazil with Missionary Brian Lawson. Your giving made possible a shipment of 50,000 Portuguese Chick tracts to supply these missionaries.

In addition, we have ordered printing of tracts for Missionary Jonathan Hernandez in Tabatinga, deep in the Amazon basin. Getting tracts to him has always been challenging, but a printing has been ordered which will travel down the Amazon River to reach him.

Nicaragua

Missionary Ricardo Portillo came to the U.S. on a short furlough. Your giving provided him with 8,000 Chick tracts to take back with him on the plane in his luggage. Shipping there is very difficult, so this was a special opportunity to help this church planter.

Colombia

Five-thousand more tracts were shipped to Missionary Mark Gerosin in Medellin, Colombia, to help with a church plant in Pitalito, a town of more than 100,000 people.
